Eligibility and Criteria for Selection of Participants: A participant must be (i) a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, (ii) a school teacher or college/university faculty, (iii) a graduate student, undergraduate junior or senior student who intends to teach in the future in modern foreign languages or area studies. Applicants need to submit: (1) fully completed application with none refundable (cashier check only) fee of \$50.00; (2) two- three trouble space typed page (s) easy describing reasons for applying including how you plan to use the experience you acquire in Tanzania to improve African area studies curriculum in your classroom and your willingness in making make presentation in your schools, district, regional ,state and national conferences, as well as qualifications for participation in the program; (3) participant's contribution fee of \$1000.00 in cashier or personal check only to defray costs not covered by the US Department of Education or AIRHD including (a portion of a round trip airline ticket, local transportation in Tanzania, some entrance fees to museums and tour guides, arrangement of 1 or 2- day homestay with local teachers, teaching supplies, pre-departure orientation and follow-up seminars, etc.). This fee is refundable **only if not selected to travel** or if selected to travel, a written request to drop out of the program earlier enough to avoid additional cost. (4) two professional letters of recommendation from the school principal and supervisor; (5) a resume or curriculum vitae; and (6) unofficial transcripts of undergraduate and graduate work only for students. Selected participants must attend a 3-day Pre-Departure Orientation scheduled on June 6-8, 2019 at AIRHD office 1726 Montreal Circle, Suite 210 Tucker, GA 30084. **Deadline to submit all application materials is March 8, 2019** and final selection notification will be **on March 25, 2019. Final selections are subject to approval by the U.S. Department of Education, Washington, DC .by April 19. Tentative date for travel to Tanzania is June 14-July,19, 2019.** All application materials should be mailed to American Institute for Resource and Human Development, Inc., P.O.
