Applicants need to submit: (1) fully completed application with none refundable (cashier cheek only) fee of \$50.00; (2) two- three trouble space typed page (s) easy describing reasons for applying including how you plan to use the experience you acquire in Tanzania to improve African area studies curriculum in your classroom and your willingness in making make presentation in your schools, district, regional ,state and national conferences, as well as qualifications for participation in the program; (3) participant's contribution fee of \$1000.00 in cashier or personal cheek only to defray costs not covered by the US Department of Education or AIRHD including (a portion of a round trip airline ticket, local transportation in Tanzania, some entrance fees to museums and tour guides, arrangement of 1 or 2- day homestay with local teachers, teaching supplies, pre-departure orientation and follow-up seminars, etc.).
